This edition was created for several reasons: 1) to have an arrangement of this movement with a more accessible keyboard part that could be played on the piano; 2) to include several optional ornaments for the melody line; and, 3) to set several different texts to this chorale that would work throughout the Church Year. It is not intended that more than one text be sung in worship as though this were a multiverse setting. This edition may also be accompanied by other editions that include an organ or other instrumental parts.
